RULES OF THE MEMBERS CLUB AT ALDARRA

1. Member Tee Off Times

All members must check in with the starter before commencing play.

TEE TIMES

- a. Closed all Mondays except certain holidays.
- b. Closed on Tuesdays when the Tuesday follows a Monday that we are open.

2. Guest Rules

- a. Members bringing a guest(s) to the club to play golf should notify the Head Golf Professional or his assistant in advance regarding available playing time. Groups comprised of all members will have priority.
- b. Guest play guidelines are to be strictly adhered to by all members.
- c. Golfing guests residing within Western Washington counties, can play with a member not more than once per month. Guests cannot play a round of golf with two separate members on two separate occasions during a given month. The intent of this rule is again, that a specific guest is only allowed to play one round per month at the Club.
- d. Guest Play (Year Round)
 - a. Tuesday thru Friday
No Restrictions
 - b. Saturday, Sunday and Holidays
One guest before 11:00 and up to three afterward
- e. Immediate Family Guest Play

Spouse	24 times per year at 1/2 current guest fee
Children*	Ages 8 to 17 – Not to exceed 24 times per year no charge
Intermediate*	Ages 18 to 21 – Not to exceed 24 times per year 1/2 current guest fee

**Must be able to play and understand golf etiquette.*

**Play at the discretion of the Professional.*

3. Dress Code

All members and their guests whenever on the premises of Aldarra, regardless of the purpose of the visit shall be suitably attired in traditional business or golf attire.

Men – Golf shoes with soft spikes, long or short-sleeve shirts with a collar (shirts must be kept tucked into trousers at all times). Sweaters, golf or casual-type slacks or short pants (bermuda style) worn with an inseam of not less than eight (8) inches. Headwear should be of a traditional golfing style and not worn backwards. Headwear is not allowed in the clubhouse.

Women – Golf shoes with soft spikes, blouses, sweaters, skirts, slacks or shorts (bermuda style) worn with an inseam of not less than eight (8) inches.

Juniors & Intermediate – All Junior and Intermediate members must adhere to the dress code as described above respective to their gender.

The following attire is *not acceptable* for anyone at any time: “Jeans” of any type, tank-tops, halter-tops, cut off pants, tennis shorts, bathing suits, tee shirts, warm-up suits or gymnasium attire and business logos.

Members are responsible for their guests being properly attired. Members and their guests not so attired will be asked to dress appropriately before being allowed to use the club facilities.

Changing of shoes or clothing in parking lot prohibited. No towels are allowed to be worn on person.

4. Use of Cellular Phones on the golf course and in the clubhouse is prohibited.

5. Practice Tees, Fairways, Bunkers and Greens

Practice shall be confined to designated practice greens, tees, fairways, and bunkers. All practicing on the regular course, including putting on and approaching to regular greens and all practice on regular tees and fairways is prohibited. All practice areas are restricted to members with golfing privileges and their golfing guests who have been registered at the Pro Shop and for whom a green fee has been paid or waived.

6. Power Carts

Members and guests must observe power cart rules and designated routes for power carts as posted. Privately owned power carts are prohibited at all times. Operators of power carts must have a state driver's license. No pull carts of any type are allowed.

7. Care of the Course

Members are expected to:

- a. REPAIR ALL BALL MARKS & REPLACE ALL DIVOTS whenever made and wherever seen.
- b. Refrain from walking on the practice putting green in front of the Clubhouse except when practicing putting.
- c. Rake all foot or club marks in bunkers after playing out of them, and enter and leave all bunkers at the lowest point. Rakes must be left in the middle of the bunkers.
- d. The putter shall never be used for removing the ball from the cup.

8. Smoking is not allowed in the Clubhouse.

CLUB RULES

9. The name “Aldarra”, the golf course, the membership and use of the membership directory are not to be used for private, business or charitable purposes without prior approval from the Board of Directors.
10. Club employees are not authorized to accept cash payments for purchases by members, except for caddies.
11. **No gratuity shall be given by any member (or guest) to ANY employee of Aldarra.** Members violating this rule subject themselves to discipline and insure the prompt discharge of any employee who received such a prohibited gratuity.
12. When leaving the Club, members are required to place all articles of personal property inside the lockers and to keep the tops of lockers and adjacent floor area clear of such articles. If desired, wet items may be given to the locker room attendant to be placed in the drying room. The attendant will return them to the member’s locker when dry.
13. Complaints of members must be made by letter, addressed to the Chairman of the Board of Directors.
14. In order to promote responsible sale and use of beverage alcohol, it shall be the policy of The Members Club at Aldarra that **NO EMPLOYEE, MEMBER, VISITOR OR GUEST OF THIS CLUB SHALL FURNISH, SELL, SERVICE, AND/OR OTHERWISE SUPPLY LIQUOR TO ANY PERSON WHO APPEARS TO BE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL.**

15. As a matter of general policy, the Members Club at Aldarra conducts all of its operations free from discrimination on account of race, creed, color, national origin, age, sex, religion, pregnancy or the presence of any sensory, mental or physical handicap. All members and employees should refrain from any statements or conduct which suggests that any other member, visitor or employee of the Club would be treated adversely in any way on account of his or her race, creed, color, national origin, age, gender or the presence of any physical, sensory or mental handicap.
